| 1. | Dependent children, 16 years of age, may hunt aboard NBVC Point Mugu unaccompanied by their adult sponsor, as long as they have a valid California Hunting License and Duck Stamp, a Hunter Access Card and an approved Blind Request. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 2. | Firing in the direction of any building, communication line Runway or aircraft within 500 feet is prohibited. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 3. | The Waterfowl Hunting Committee has the authority to withdraw hunting privileges, as appropriate. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 4. | If asked by any member of the Waterfowl Committee, Security Guard, Duty Officer, Base Weapons personnel Environmental Personnel, or Game Warden to present their shot shells, gun or species taken, the hunter will comply or be considered in violation. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 5. | Blinds are assigned on a priority basis on hunting days prescribed in NBVC Point Mugu Note 1710. On any other day during the waterfowl season in Southern California blinds aboard NBVC Point Mugu may be used on a first come basis. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 6. | Hunters authorized to hunt aboard NBVC are authorized to sponsor one guest. The sponsor is responsible for all actions of his guest including the payment of the annual or daily fee, insuring the guest has a Waterfowl Hunters Access Card and the word GUEST entered in the priority block of the guest's Blind Request Prior to hunting. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 7. | Hunters may substitute copper plated lead shot for steel shot. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 8. | When requesting a blind assignment after 1100 on Monday the requester must appear at/contact the Environmental Dept office. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 9. | A hunter's approved Duck Blind Request for the day must be prominently displayed, face-up on the dash of his vehicle, in order to ease locating the hunter, if necessary. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 10. | Shotguns may be discharged in the vicinity of ammunition Bunkers if the shooter is greater than 500 feet away. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 11. | Access to blinds 11 through 13 and the Calleguas Creek must be made by boat | TRUE | FALSE |
| 12. | If a waterfowl falls into a flagged area that is too large to use a pole for retrieval, the hunter can enter the flagged area and retrieve the bird by the shortest most direct route, and exit by the same path used to enter. | TRUE | FALSE |

| 21. Hunters who can not be in their assigned blind 30 minutes prior to shooting time will not proceed into the hunting area until 30 minutes after the start of shooting time. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 22. Hunters should always know the EFFECTIVE range of their shotgun. "Sky Busting", shooting beyond effective ranges, spoils the hunting for all in nearby blinds. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 23. Dogs may be used to recover waterfowl downed in an area flagged for Salt Marsh Birds-beak. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 24. Hunters in the Calleguas Creek area must bring their own portable blind and set it up in the vicinity of the stake/pipe marking the location of the assigned hunting area. | TRUE | FALSE |
| 25. Decoys can not be set out the evening prior to an assigned day of shooting. Decoys used during hunting periods must be picked up immediately after shooting is completed. | TRUE | FALSE |
