To: Military Family Housing Residents

Subj: BUDGETARY RESTRAINTS

As fiscal year 2003 quickly comes to an end and funds continue to decrease instead of increasing, we are forced to take a hard look at the financial picture for the upcoming year. With more potential reductions on the horizon, we are being asked to adjust policies and procedures in order to accommodate changes in resource levels.

Unfortunately, due to budgetary restraints the Family Housing Office at the Naval Base Ventura County will no longer be able to provide lawn care packages, perform maintenance on lawn care equipment or replace lawn care equipment for family housing residents effective Wednesday, 1 October 2003.

You can check out (for no more than 24 hours) lawn care tools and equipment from the Family Housing Self Help Store located in Camarillo, Point Mugu or Port Hueneme. You may also "opt" to keep the lawn care package you currently have and repair it "at your own expense" when it breaks or simply turn it in.
