

From Our House to Your House

Please come into the Family Housing Office located at the Port Hueneme, Welcome Center in Building 1169 to register your complaint or discuss your problem. All complaints must be in writing; unfortunately, they cannot be taken over telephone or by e-mail. We are particularly interested in solutions.

If you're feeling apprehensive or concerned about your identity, we will keep your complaint confidential (as much as possible). We will not divulge your name or the information you have provided us. The Naval Base Ventura County Command is only interested in providing a pleasant and harmonious living and working environment for all its residents.

Yard And Garage Sales

Yard and garage sales must be limited to two consecutive days. Items should not be left outside the housing unit overnight, as this invites theft and vandalism. Signs may be posted on bulletin boards or small stick-in the ground signs. These signs may be posted no sooner than the day before the sale and must be removed by the end of the day of the sale. Signs are not to be placed on road signs, telephone poles, mailboxes, trees, etc. The yard sale signs for the month of January 2004 has increased and signs have been left on road signs located at the end of the streets in the housing area. Yard sale signs are to be removed after the garage sale is over.

Graffiti? Not At NBVC

If you notice graffiti on a fence, wall, building or even on a tree or any structure on the base, call Pride Industries Service Desk at 982-6789 and report it. It is our housing policy to have the graffiti removed as soon as possible. If you notice anyone painting graffiti on anything call Security immediately at 982-4591.

Vacating Housing

PCS orders? Buying a house? Getting discharged? Retiring from the military? Family separation? Divorce? No longer want to reside in military housing? Don't forget a 30 day notice is required for whatever reason you may be vacating government quarters. If you are living off base a written 30 day notification to your landlord is required.

Reminder About Shopping Carts

Shopping carts are the property of the Navy Exchange and Commissary and are intended for the use of all patrons and not just for individual customers to transport groceries home. Therefore, the shopping carts should not be taken from the vicinity of the stores and parking areas. If you are caught with a shopping cart outside of the vicinity of the stores; you can be stopped and issued a ticket by Base Force Protection. Your cooperation and understanding in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Strictly Forbidden

Did you know? It is strictly forbidden to do even the simplest automobile maintenance in your assigned housing area. For example, if you happen to spill that motor oil you changed, then you will be held liable for the expense of the Hazardous Material Clean Up. Our advice! Dressing Up The "Milk House"

The original construction of the Milk House was completed in 1918 and was a one level country structure. The house was extensively remodeled in 1945 for conversion by the Navy into Family Housing Officer Quarters. Again, in 1954 it was remodeled even further and a second story was added within the original Milk House structure with a floor area of 1,758 square feet with three bedrooms and two baths. Recreational Centers Usage

Family Housing funds were used for the acquisition of the Midway, Pearl and the upcoming Mugu Recreational Centers. Family Housing funds are used for operation and maintenance of recreation centers. The Navy Family Housing Office is responsible for the daily operation of the Recreation Centers, which includes scheduling, providing access and ensuring that the facilities are well maintained.

All military and their families stationed in the Ventura County area living on base or off the bases can use the Rec Centers. Spouses must have a Power of Attorney if the military person is out of the area. If the spouse is making the reservation, a copy of the Power of Attorney must be issued to the Housing Office.

The recreation centers were constructed in Navy family housing areas to provide a convenient location in which to conduct the following celebrations: birthday, baby showers, religious events, retirement parties and wedding anniversaries for military residents only. The recreational centers will not be available for any business, enterprise or command functions.

In order to ensure total fairness to housing residents, all reservations for the recreational centers are taken on a first come, first serve - sign in basis only. Reservations will be taken at the Family Housing Office located in Building 1169 of the Family Welcome Center located at Port Hueneme (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday between the hours of 0730 and 1600 and Wednesday between the hours of 0930 and 1600). Remember, this must be done in person and no more than one (1) month prior! Calling ahead will not guarantee a reservation; nor can housing personnel hold the facility because an individual called to check the status of the recreational center.

The recreational centers must be cleaned and properly maintained or your privileges

could be revoked and you could be involuntarily charged for any damages. No co-sharing or trading off will be authorized. No alcohol will be allowed within the recreational centers unless prior approval and documentation is provided to the Housing Office with signatures from the service member's Command and Force Protection.

The recreational centers are closed from December 31 until January 2 of each year. Please note: reservations can be cancelled without prior notification in cases of emergencies (fire to a resident housing unit, slab leak, etc.).

Things to consider when making your reservation

If you want the Midway Recreational Center for a "Sunday Brunch" on Aug. 23 you would have to come into the Family Housing Office to reserve the center on July 21. Why, you ask? Well - this is what happens! Unfortunately, the Housing Office is not open to take reservations on Saturdays or Sundays. We reserve the recreational centers for the entire weekend, you would have to pick up the keys from the Housing Office for the weekend on Friday, Aug. 21. Thus, your reservation date would be for July 21.

If you wanted the Pearl Recreational Center for a "Hoe Down" on Saturday, July 4 - you would have to come into the Family Housing Office to reserve the center on 2 June. Again, you ask the question why? Because Friday, July 3 would be the official holiday - which means you would have to pick up the keys for your "hoe down" on July 2. Thus, making your reservation date June 2.
